Any 9 objection? 10 Not hearing any objections, Estrella Herman is hereby 11 appointed court reporter pro tem and is authorized to report 12 remotely. 13 Good morning. THE COURT REPORTER: Good morning, Your Honor. 14 15 THE COURT: The matter is here for a hearing on motion 16 for final approval of class action settlement. I have received 17 a declaration -- supplemental declaration of Luiggy Segura 18 regarding the dissemination of the notice. However, I am 19 concerned that the Court is not up to date and not sufficient 20 time has been given with regard to responses because of late 2.1 notices. 2.2 In review of where we are, according to the declaration, since the initial mailing, which -- let me just 23 24 get the dates in front of me. I'm going to review where we 25 are. 26 On October 19, 2020, the administrator, JND, received a class data file. On November 25, 2020, JND caused the 27

postcard notices to be mailed to 11,847 names. JND also caused

the summary notice to be published in Investor's -- in the Investor's Business Daily on November 30, 2020, and the Wall Street Journal on November 30 and PRNewswire on November 30.

Since the initial mailing, JND continued to disseminate copies of the postcard notice and notice packets in response to requests from potential class members and brokers or nominees through February 8, 2021. As of February 8, 8,426 postcard notices, 832 notice packets were returned by JND -- excuse me -- returned to JND. Then JND received updated addresses and forwarded notices to the updated addresses and re-mailed the 4,786 postcard notices to updated addresses.

On January 25, 2021, two months after the initial mailing, JND received a file from Apex Clearing Corporation containing 65,357 names and addresses. This file was in addition to the file previously provided by Apex to JND on December 9, 2020. After confirming that the January 25, 2021, list was not sent by Apex in error and following deduplication efforts, JND identified 64,235 new names and addresses. JND mailed postcards to the 64,235 Apex potential settlement class members on January 29, 2021.

That was past the response deadline date of
January 25. So these postcard notices to potential class
members belatedly identified by Apex advised that any
objections and requests for exclusions received from the new
potential class members prior to the final hearing would be
presented to the Court. So the original response deadline was
January 25; but, obviously, the new mailing didn't take place
until January 29. As of February 10, JND received -- I'm

trying to see how many claims were received -- two objections, seven requests for exclusion.

So based upon this, the Court is going to continue the hearing and order that the settlement administrator file a supplemental declaration confirming the number of claims received as of the response deadline date, that's January 25; any late-filed claims; any opt-outs; and any objections received; also confirming the final cost of settlement administration and providing the beginning and ending dates for any publication of the notices. They're also to attach a copy of the long-form notice that was issued to the class provided on the website.

Also, I would order counsel to disclose their fee percentage split and whether the plaintiffs have given written consent to that. And then we will discuss at the next hearing about whether we should recognize the late-filed claims, opt-outs, or objections based upon the late mailing.

So now let's get the time for all this information to be accumulated, and we'll set another hearing date on this. We'll continue this matter until March 26 at 9:00 a.m.

And I'll order the administrator to submit a supplemental report in response to all these issues about the late notice and update confirming the number of claims, any late-filed claims, opt-outs, and objections, the final cost of settlement administration, the beginning and end dates of publication, and also for counsel to submit the evidence with regard to the fee split and consent of clients. And that report should be submitted no later than March 15.
